

### INDIE THRILLER


Cutter is a story about legacy, a story about coming to terms with someday dying and someday being forgotten.

Chloe deflects her fear of being forgotten by obsessively photographing others.






An encounter in a steam room with a smalltime thug makes Chloe realize she can change people for the better. Roan pushes Chloe to use the closet for good.

The closet gives Chloe a new way to think about her legacy.










**Chloe Bennet**
